BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 329, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated		
3	and to read as follows:		
4	" <u>§329-</u> Tableting and encapsulating machines; sale;		
5	possession. (a) Except as provided in subsection (b), it is		
6	unlawful for any person to possess, purchase, deliver, sell, or		
7	possess with intent to sell a tableting machine or encapsulating		
8	machine if the person knows, or reasonably should know, that it		
9	will be used to manufacture, compound, convert, produce,		
10	process, prepare, or otherwise introduce into the human body a		
11	controlled substance in violation of this chapter.		
12	(b) This section shall not apply to:		
13	(1) Any pharmacist or other authorized person who sells or		
14	furnishes a substance upon the prescription of a		
15	physician, dentist, podiatrist, or veterinarian;		
16	(2) Any physician, dentist, podiatrist, or veterinarian		
17	who administers or furnishes a substance to patients;		



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1	(3)	Any manufacturer or wholesaler licensed by the State
2		who sells, transfers, or otherwise furnishes a
3		substance to a licensed pharmacist, physician,
4		dentist, podiatrist, or veterinarian; and
5	(4)	Any manufacturer, retailer, or wholesaler licensed by
6		the State who is subject to the reporting requirements
7		of section 329-63 and who sells, transfers, receives,
8		or brings in from outside the State an encapsulating
9		or tableting machine for the sale or transfer to any
10		person included in subsection (1) through (3).
11	(C)	For the purposes of this section, "encapsulating
12	machine"	and "tableting machine" shall mean any manual,
13	semiautom	atic, or fully automatic equipment that can be used to
14	fill shel	ls or capsules with powdered or granular solids or
15	semisolid	material to produce coherent solid contents."
16	SECT	ION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
17	SECT	ION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2024.

Controlled Substances; Encapsulating Machines; Tabulating Machines; Restrictions

Except under certain circumstances, makes it unlawful for a person to possess, purchase, deliver, sell, or intend to sell an encapsulating machine or tabulating machine when the person knows, or reasonably should know, that the machine will be used to manufacture, compound, convert, produce, prepare, or otherwise introduce into the human body a controlled substance.
