A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. (a) The med-QUEST division of the department
of human services shall adopt rules pursuant to chapter 91,
Hawaii Revised Statutes, to authorize reimbursements for remote
ultrasound procedures and remote fetal nonstress tests.

- 5 (b) The rules adopted pursuant to subsection (a) shall6 require that:
- 7 (1) Each remote ultrasound procedure or remote fetal 8 nonstress test be reimbursed using the same current 9 procedural terminology, or CPT, codes as if the 10 procedure was performed in the clinic and the same 11 standard of care is met; provided that any healthcare 12 provider offering remote ultrasound or remote 13 nonstress tests may also use other appropriate CPT 14 codes for home visiting services, telehealth, or other 15 remote services;
- 16 (2) Each applicable healthcare provider maintains the same17 standard of care that the provider would otherwise
