H.B. NO. **1727**

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO GROWTH AND DEVELOPMENT IN SEXUALITY HEALTH EDUCATION CURRICULUM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that an understanding of 2 fetal growth and development is essential to a comprehensive 3 sexual health education program. The Centers for Disease 4 Control and Prevention recommend that sexual health education 5 curriculum be consistent with scientific research and medically 6 accurate. Further, the CDC also recognizes that students with 7 access to such sexual health education programs are more likely 8 to have fewer sexual partners, use protection during sex, and 9 postpone engaging in sexual activity. The purpose of this Act 10 is to provide students with a medically accurate understanding 11 of fetal growth and development to reduce their likelihood of 12 engaging in high risk sexual behavior.

13 SECTION 2. Chapter 321, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 14 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated 15 and to read as follows:

11		every stage of human development inside the uterus,
12		noting significant markers in cell growth and organ
13		development for every week of pregnancy until birth.
14	(b)	Sexuality health education programs funded by the
15	State sha	ll include:
16	(1)	A high-definition ultrasound video, at least three
17		minutes in duration, showing the development of the
18		brain, heart, sex organs, and other vital organs in
19		early fetal development; and
20	(2)	A high-quality, computer-generated rendering or
21		animation showing the process of fertilization and

4	(c) The superintendent of education shall ensure the		
5	requirements of this section are included in the Hawaii health		
6	content and sexual health education standards.		
7	(d) For the purposes of this section:		
8	"Human growth and development discussion" means an oral,		
9	written, or digital lesson, lecture, or presentation about human		
10	biology related to pregnancy and human development inside the		
11	womb.		
12	"Sexuality health education" means education in any medium		
13	regarding human development and sexuality, including education		
14	on pregnancy, family planning, and sexually transmitted		
15	diseases."		
16	SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.		
17	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2024.
