A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO WORLD PEACE DAY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The legislature finds that World Peace Day,
also officially known as the International Day of Peace, is a
United Nations-sanctioned holiday observed around the world on
the twenty-first day of September. Originally established in
1981 by the United Nations General Assembly, the holiday is
dedicated to world peace through observing twenty-four hours of
non-violence and cease-fire.

8 The legislature further finds that as international 9 conflict continues in certain parts of the world, the 10 recognition and aspiration toward world peace becomes more 11 important and significant.

12 The purpose of this Act is to designate World Peace Day as 13 a state holiday in substitution of the existing Good Friday 14 holiday.

15 SECTION 2. Section 8-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 16 amended to read as follows:
