
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE AGRIBUSINESS DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 163D-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending the definition of "enterprise" to read as
3 follows:

4 ""Enterprise" means a business with its principal place of
5 business in Hawaii, which is, or proposes to be, engaged in
6 agricultural crop development, development of new value-added
7 products, enhancement of existing agricultural commodities, and
8 the application of existing agricultural appurtenant facilities
9 to productive uses; provided that the majority of whatever the
10 corporation produces shall be produced for export. "Enterprise"
11 includes a business engaged in agritourism."

12 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

13 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000.
