In accordance with section 9 of article VII, of 5 the Constitution of the State of Hawaii and sections 37-91 and 6 37-93, Hawaii Revised Statutes, the legislature has determined 7 that the appropriation contained in this Act will cause the 8 state general fund expenditure ceiling for fiscal year 2024-2025 9 to be exceeded by \$ per cent. The reasons , or 10 for exceeding the general fund expenditure ceiling are that the 11 appropriation made in this Act is necessary to serve the public 12 interest and to meet the needs provided for by this Act. 13 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general 14 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$2,500,000 or so much 15 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2024-2025 to carry 16 out the purposes of this Act. 17 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of 18 budget and finance for the purposes of this Act.

19 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed20 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

21 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2024.
