
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO DRIVING WHILE INTOXICATED.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. (a) There is established an intoxicated
2 driving reduction working group within the department of
3 transportation to study, investigate, and recommend
4 transformative changes to the State's existing laws relating to
5 the operation of a vehicle while under the influence of an
6 intoxicant to reduce incidents of intoxicated driving.

7 (b) The working group shall consist of the following
8 members or their designees:

9 (1) The director of transportation, who shall serve as the
10 chair of the working group;

11 (2) A prosecutor from each county;

12 (3) A public defender from each county;

13 (4) The chair of the house standing committee on
14 transportation; and

15 (5) The chair of the senate standing committee on
16 transportation.



1 (c) The chair of the working group shall invite the
2 following individuals to become members of the working group:

3 (1) A representative from Mothers Against Drunk Driving;

4 (2) A representative from the Hawaii Alcohol Policy
5 Alliance; and

6 (3) Any other person that the chair deems relevant to the
7 purposes of the working group.

8 (d) Members of the working shall serve without
9 compensation and may conduct meetings remotely to carry out the
10 purposes of the working group.

11 (e) The working group shall study and investigate:

12 (1) The role of sobriety checkpoints in high traffic
13 areas;

14 (2) Routine saturation patrols;

15 (3) The impact of reducing a person's permissible blood
16 alcohol level while operating a vehicle from .08 per
17 cent to .05 per cent; and

18 (4) Means of attracting additional law enforcement to
19 sobriety checkpoints and saturation patrols.

20 (f) In conducting its work, the working group shall:
