A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated out of the general
revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$100,000 or so much
thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2024-2025 for the
preparation of an environmental impact statement for the
drilling of non-potable water wells on individual parcels at
Panaewa and Pahoa agricultural parks.

7 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of8 agriculture for the purposes of this Act.

9 SECTION 2. In accordance with section 9 of article VII, of 10 the Constitution of the State of Hawaii and sections 37-91 and 11 37-93, Hawaii Revised Statutes, the legislature has determined 12 that the appropriations contained in this Act will cause the 13 state general fund expenditure ceiling for fiscal year 2024-2025 14 to be exceeded by \$, or per cent. The reasons 15 for exceeding the general fund expenditure ceiling are that the 16 appropriations made in this Act are necessary to serve the 17 public interest and to meet the needs provided for by this Act.
