A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HAWAII EMERGENCY HOME SALES MORATORIUM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. (a) Notwithstanding any law to the contrary,

2 only an individual who is:

3 (1) A current resident of Hawaii; or

4 (2) A former resident of Hawaii,

5 may obtain an ownership interest in residential property in 6 Hawaii.

(b) A real estate broker or real estate salesperson
8 licensed under chapter 467, Hawaii Revised Statutes, shall not
9 buy, offer to buy, or negotiate the purchase of residential real
10 estate, or the improvements thereon, for an individual who is
11 not a current resident of Hawaii or a former resident of Hawaii
12 without disclosing the prohibition under this Act to the
13 individual.

14 (c) This Act shall not apply to:

15 (1) Any individual who acquires residential property, or
16 an ownership interest in residential property, through
17 a will, devise, descent, or by operation of law; and

(2) Any ownership interest in residential property by an
 individual that existed before the effective date of
 this Act.

4 (d) For purposes of this Act:

5 "Current resident of Hawaii" means an individual who is6 currently domiciled in Hawaii.

7 "Former resident of Hawaii" means an individual who was 8 born, was previously domiciled, was registered to vote, or lived 9 in Hawaii, but is currently domiciled in a location outside of 10 Hawaii.

SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were begun before its effective date.

SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval; provided that this Act shall be repealed on the last date of the final proclamation relating to affordable housing issued by the governor; provided further that the governor shall notify the chief justice, legislature, and revisor of statutes no later than twenty days prior to the expiration of the final proclamation relating to affordable housing that the governor

Report Title:

Residential Property Sales; Moratorium; Non-Residents; Real Estate Broker; Real Estate Salespersons

Description:

Establishes a temporary restriction that only current and former residents of Hawaii may purchase residential property. Prohibits real estate brokers and real estate salespersons from buying, offering to buy, or negotiating the purchase of residential real estate for someone who is not a current or former resident without disclosing the temporary restriction. Repeals the moratorium when the Governor's last proclamation on affordable housing expires.
