BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 78, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
2	by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to
3	read as follows:
4	" <u>§78-</u> Limitation on salaries of employees in the
5	executive branch of the State. With regard to the salaries of
6	employees in the executive branch of the State:
7	(1) No board or commission shall authorize a base salary
8	for a position, regardless of whether the position is
9	civil service or exempt; and
10	(2) No employee shall be paid a base salary,
11	in excess of the amount designated in the budget enacted by the
12	legislature or other legislative enactment, unless approved by
13	the legislature."
14	SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
15	matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
16	begun before its effective date.

SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
