BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to reclassify,
 repeal, or abolish certain non-general funds of the department
 of agriculture, pursuant to the recommendations made by the
 auditor in auditor's report no. 23-13, and to transfer any
 unencumbered balance of any repealed or abolished fund to
 another fund.

7 SECTION 2. The aquaculture loan reserve fund, a special 8 fund administratively established in 1972, is abolished and any 9 unencumbered balance shall lapse to the credit of the 10 aquaculture loan revolving fund established pursuant to section 11 219-4, Hawaii Revised Statutes.

SECTION 3. The office of Hawaiian affairs ceded lands
proceeds, a trust fund administratively established in 2003,
shall be reclassified as a trust account.
