A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the northern
extension of the Lahaina bypass was envisioned to be funded by
the rental car surcharge. This fund, created by the legislature
specifically for the Lahaina bypass has since been shifted to
other projects, unrelated to the bypass, in direct conflict with
the original justification for taxing rental cars.

7 The legislature further finds that because of the recent 8 wildfires, population growth quickly centered to the areas to be 9 serviced by the Lahaina bypass. Additionally, plans for future 10 development in the area, including projects with the department 11 of Hawaiian homelands and the Hawaii housing finance development 12 corporation, will increase the population by adding thousands of 13 homes north of Lahaina. Given that this segment of the bypass 14 will also service the visitors to the area and will generate most of the rental car traffic on the island, it is appropriate 15 16 to utilize potential disaster and rental car funds for the



1 construction, maintenance, and repair of the Lahaina bypass 2 north. 3 SECTION 2. Section 248-9, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 4 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: 5 Moneys in the state highway fund may be expended for "(a) 6 the following purposes: 7 (1) To pay the costs of operation, maintenance, and repair of the state highway system, including without 8 9 limitation, the cost of equipment and general 10 administrative overhead; 11 (2) To pay the costs of acquisition, including real 12 property and interests therein; planning; designing; construction; and reconstruction of the state highway 13 14 system and bikeways, including without limitation, the 15 cost of equipment and general administrative overhead; To reimburse the general fund for interest on and 16 (3) 17 principal of general obligation bonds issued to 18 finance highway projects where the bonds are 19 designated to be reimbursable out of the state highway 20 fund;

13	SECTION 3. Section 251-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is	
14	amended b	y amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
15	"(a)	There is levied and shall be assessed and collected
16	each month a rental motor vehicle surcharge tax of \$5 a day, or	
17	any portion of a day that a rental motor vehicle is rented or	
18	leased[-]; provided that, beginning July 1, 2024, the rental	
19	motor vehicle surcharge tax shall increase to \$7 a day, and the	
20	difference shall be allocated for the Lahaina bypass north.	
21	Beginning	January 1, 2022, and each subsequent year on January 1



until December 31, 2027, the rental motor vehicle surcharge tax 1 2 shall increase by \$0.50. The rental motor vehicle surcharge tax 3 shall be levied upon the lessor; provided that the tax shall not 4 be levied on the lessor if: 5 The lessor is renting the vehicle to replace a vehicle (1) 6 of the lessee that: (A) Is being repaired; or 7 8 (B) Has been stolen and is unrecovered or will not be 9 repaired due to a total loss of the vehicle; and 10 A record of the repair order, the stolen vehicle (2) 11 record, or total loss vehicle claim for the vehicle is 12 retained either by the lessor for two years for 13 verification purposes or by a motor vehicle repair 14 dealer for two years as provided in section 437B-16. 15 In addition to the requirements imposed by section 251-4, a 16 lessor shall disclose, to the department, the portion of the 17 remittance attributed to the county in which the motor vehicle 18 was operated under rental or lease. A peer-to-peer car-sharing 19 program, as defined in chapter 279L, shall be subject to the tax imposed by this subsection and be subject to the other 20 21 requirements of this chapter."
