5	an election at a meeting,] If an election is to be held by

7	present in person or represented by proxy shall have a number of
8	votes equal to the unit owner's voting percentage multiplied by
9	the number of positions to be filled at the election.
10	(b) Each unit owner shall be entitled to cumulate the
11	individual votes of the unit owner and give all of the votes to
12	one [ <del>nomince</del> ] <u>candidate</u> or distribute the <u>individual</u> votes among
13	any or all of the [nominees.] candidates.
14	(c) The [ <del>nomince or nominees</del> ] candidate or candidates
15	receiving the highest number of votes under this section, up to
16	the total number of positions to be filled, shall be deemed
17	elected and shall be given the longest term.
