BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 414D-147, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
 amended to read as follows:

"[+]\$414D-147[+] Quorum and voting. (a) Except as
otherwise provided in this chapter, the articles, or the bylaws,
a quorum of a board of directors consists of a majority of the
directors in office immediately before a meeting begins. In no
event may the articles or bylaws authorize a quorum of fewer
than the greater of one-third of the number of directors in
office or two directors.

10 (b) If a quorum is present when a vote is taken, the 11 affirmative vote of a majority of directors present is the act 12 of the board unless this chapter, the articles, or the bylaws 13 require the vote of a greater number of directors.

14 (c) This section shall not apply to any planned community 15 association governed by chapter 421J or condominiums governed by 16 chapter 514B."
