A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE CERTIFICATION OF DOCUMENTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The Hawaii Revised Statutes is amended by
adding a new chapter to be appropriately designated and to read
as follows:
"CHAPTER
APOSTILLES AND CERTIFICATIONS
§ -1 Definitions. As used in this chapter, unless the
context otherwise requires:
"Apostille" means a certification issued to authenticate
documents pursuant to the Hague Treaty.
"Hague Treaty" refers to the convention, adopted in the
Hague in 1961, that created a simplified form of document
certification for countries that joined the convention.
"Non-apostille certification" means a certification issued
by the lieutenant governor to authenticate a document for a
country that does not recognize the Hague Treaty.
§ -2 Fee. (a) The office of the lieutenant governor
shall charge and collect a fee for each apostille or non-

There is appropriated out of the general 6 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$12,000 or so much 7 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2024-2025 to be 8 deposited into the apostilles and certifications special fund 9 established pursuant to section -3, Hawaii Revised Statutes. 10 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the apostilles and 11 certifications special fund established pursuant to 12 section -3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, the sum of \$12,000 or so 13 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2024-2025 for 14 operational and administrative expenses of the apostille and 15 certification of document services.

16 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the office of the 17 lieutenant governor for the purposes of this Act.
