# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII CONFERENCE CENTER REVOLVING  
FUND.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The legislature finds that streamlining  
2 university procedure regarding existing conference center  
3 revolving funds is a matter of statewide concern pursuant to  
4 article X, section 6, of the Hawaii State Constitution.

5           SECTION 2. Section 304A-2273, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
6 amended to read as follows:

7           " ~~[+] §304A-2273 [+] [Community college]~~ University of Hawaii  
8 conference center revolving fund. (a) There is established the  
9 ~~[community college]~~ university of Hawaii conference center  
10 revolving fund for conference center programs conducted by the  
11 ~~[various community colleges.]~~ university. The university may  
12 establish and collect fees and charges for the costs of  
13 providing these services. All fees, charges, and other moneys  
14 collected in conjunction with the conference center ~~[program]~~  
15 programs of ~~[each community college]~~ the university shall be  
16 deposited in separate accounts within the revolving fund. The



1 university may establish accounts under the university of Hawaii  
2 conference center revolving fund to facilitate the  
3 administration of this fund among the various campuses and  
4 operating units of the university of Hawaii system. The  
5 ~~[chancellor of each community college or a designee]~~ university  
6 is authorized to expend funds from the appropriate account in  
7 the revolving fund for all costs associated with conducting  
8 conferences, seminars, and courses provided by the conference  
9 center ~~[program]~~ programs, including but not limited to  
10 expenses for honoraria~~[ ]~~; hotel and room rentals~~[ ]~~; food and  
11 refreshment~~[ ]~~; printing and mailing~~[ ]~~; airfare and per diem~~[ ]~~  
12 ~~leis~~; lei; rental of audiovisual equipment~~[ ]~~; and  
13 ~~[conference]~~ other conference-related services, fees, supplies  
14 and materials, without regard to section 103D-1002 and any  
15 competitive bidding requirements pursuant to state procurement  
16 requirements.

17 (b) The ~~[chancellors of the community colleges]~~ university  
18 shall prepare an annual report to the legislature accounting for  
19 all income and expenditures of each separate account within the  
20 revolving fund."



1 SECTION 3. Section 304A-2272, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 repealed.

3 ~~["§304A-2272 Conference center revolving fund, University~~  
4 ~~of Hawaii at Hilo. (a) There is established the conference~~  
5 ~~center revolving fund for conference center programs conducted~~  
6 ~~by the University of Hawaii at Hilo. All fees, charges, and~~  
7 ~~other moneys collected in conjunction with conference center~~  
8 ~~programs shall be deposited in the revolving fund. The~~  
9 ~~chancellor of the University of Hawaii at Hilo or the~~  
10 ~~chancellor's designee is authorized to expend funds from the~~  
11 ~~revolving fund for all costs associated with conferences,~~  
12 ~~seminars, and courses provided by conference center programs,~~  
13 ~~including but not limited to expenses for honoraria, hotel and~~  
14 ~~room rentals, food and refreshment, printing and mailing,~~  
15 ~~airfare and per diem, lei, rental of audiovisual equipment, and~~  
16 ~~conference supplies and materials, without regard to any~~  
17 ~~competitive bidding requirements pursuant to chapter 103D.~~  
18 ~~(b) The chancellor of the University of Hawaii at Hilo~~  
19 ~~shall submit a report to the legislature no later than twenty~~  
20 ~~days prior to the convening of each regular session that~~



1 ~~includes an accounting for all income and expenditures of the~~  
2 ~~revolving fund under this section."]~~

3 SECTION 4. The conference center revolving fund repealed  
4 by section 3 of this Act is abolished and any remaining  
5 unencumbered balance shall lapse to the credit of the university  
6 of Hawaii conference center revolving fund established pursuant  
7 to section 2 of this Act.

8 SECTION 5. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
9 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

10 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.

Establishes the University of Hawaii Conference Center Revolving Fund and authorizes the University of Hawaii to establish accounts under the fund to facilitate the administration of the revolving fund for conference center programs among various campuses and operating units of the University of Hawaii System. Repeals the Conference Center Revolving Fund for the University of Hawaii at Hilo. Lapses funds to the University of Hawaii Conference Center Revolving Fund. Effective 7/1/2050. (SD1)
