
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE FORTIETH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$82,304,000 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2024-2025
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the fortieth
6 representative district, as follows:

- 7 1. Holomua elementary school
- 8 Plans, land, design, construction, and
9 equipment and appurtenances for new
10 three-story classroom building to allow
11 students to move to a single track from
12 the State's only multi track.

 5 Campbell high school and Ilima

13 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
 14 shall be expended by the department of education.

15 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital
 16 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
 17 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;
 18 provided that all moneys from the appropriation unencumbered as
 19 of June 30, 2026, shall lapse as of that date.


20 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2024.
