
A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR PUBLIC EMPLOYMENT COST ITEMS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 PART I

2 SECTION 1. In accordance with section 9 of article VII, of
3 the Constitution of the State of Hawaii and sections 37-91 and
4 37-93, Hawaii Revised Statutes, the legislature has determined
5 that the appropriations contained in this Act will cause the
6 state general fund expenditure ceiling for fiscal year 2024-2025
7 to be exceeded by \$, or per cent. The reasons
8 for exceeding the general fund expenditure ceiling are that the
9 appropriations made in this Act are necessary to serve the
10 public interest and to meet the needs provided for by this Act.

11 SECTION 2. There is appropriated from the general revenues
12 of the State of Hawaii to the senate, house of representatives,
13 and legislative agencies indicated below, the following sums or
14 so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2024-2025,
15 to fund Hawaii employer-union health benefits trust fund costs
16 and other cost adjustments authorized by chapter 89C, Hawaii

10 SECTION 3. Funds appropriated by this part shall be
11 allotted to the heads of the respective chamber or legislative
12 agencies for expenditure for the purposes of this part.

13 PART II

14 SECTION 4. Cost items and cost adjustments provided in
15 this Act for any legislative officer or employee whose
16 compensation is paid, in whole or in part, from federal,
17 special, or other funds shall be paid wholly or proportionately,
18 as the case may be, from the respective funds.

19 SECTION 5. Funds appropriated by this Act that are not
20 expended or encumbered by the end of the fiscal year for which
21 the appropriation is made shall lapse as of that date.



1 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
