9	prayer; provided that:	
10	(1)	No public school student shall be compelled, against
11		the student's objections or the objections of the
12		student's parent or guardian, to participate in
13		prayer;
14	(2)	No public school teacher or staff member shall
15		admonish, discipline, or harass a student based on the
16		student's participation or non-participation in

1	(3) No public school teacher or staff member shall be		
2	admonished, disciplined, or harassed for either		
3	deciding or declining to supervise any location in		
4	which students are praying.		
5	(b) A copy of this section shall be posted in a		
6	conspicuous location at each public school that is subject to		
7	this section.		
8	(c) The department shall adopt rules under chapter 91 to		
9	carry out the purposes of this section."		
10	SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that		
11	matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were		
12	begun before its effective date.		
13	SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.		
14	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
