
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
THIRTY-FIRST REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$35,982,000 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2023-2024
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the thirty-
6 first representative district, as follows:

7 1. Aliamanu elementary school
8 Plans, land, design, construction, and
9 equipment and appurtenances for the
10 redesign and expansion of the common
11 area, offices, and conference room and
12 additional storage.

1 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital
2 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
3 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;
4 provided that all moneys from the appropriation unencumbered as
5 of June 30, 2026, shall lapse as of that date.

6 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2023.
