
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAII TECHNOLOGY DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the Hawaii
2 technology development corporation is a key state agency in the
3 development and support of the State's manufacturing industry.
4 Furthermore, continued support for the manufacturing industry is
5 essential to Hawaii's economy.

6 The legislature further finds that the Hawaii technology
7 development corporation's manufacturing assistance program plays
8 an important role in providing support to many Hawaii-based
9 manufacturers.

10 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds for the
11 manufacturing assistance program under the Hawaii technology
12 development corporation.

13 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
14 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$1,500,000 or so much
15 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 and the
16 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
17 2024-2025 for the operations, administration, and provision of

1 grants for the manufacturing assistance program under the Hawaii
2 technology development corporation.

3 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the Hawaii
4 technology development corporation for the purposes of this Act.

5 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2023.
