

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FERAL CHICKEN MANAGEMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. (a) The department of land and natural					
2	resources and department of agriculture shall collaborate on					
3	feral chicken management projects to manage feral chicken					
4	populations; mitigate the impacts of feral chickens on native					
5	habitats and ecosystems; and reduce their disturbance to					
6	indigenous species of wildlife and plants, agriculture, and					
7	communities. A secondary goal of feral chicken management shall					
8	be to generate a viable source of food to assist in feeding the					
9	State's houseless or hungry.					
10	(b) Feral chicken management shall include:					
11	(1) A program to encourage the beneficial use of					
12	carcasses, including retail and nonprofit options for					
13	feeding the houseless and hungry, which shall include:					
14	(A) Authority and capacity for ante- and post-mortem					
15	inspections, slaughtering, and processing of					
16	feral chickens; and					



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1		(B)	Best management practices for the safe handling
2			of a carcass from the time the feral chicken is
3			caught to the time it is processed;
4	(2)	Fund	ing mechanisms to support feral chicken
5		mana	gement, including:
6		(A)	Sources of seed money to develop and initiate
7			programs;
8		(B)	Public-private partnerships to reduce reliance on
9			public funds;
10		(C)	Hunting fees, sales to local farms, and other
11			cost recovery methods to subsidize costs; and
12		(D)	Potential public and private grant funding to
13			facilitate implementation, such as Clean Water
14			Act funding to assist with practices to reduce
15			reef sedimentation;
16	(3)	Prog	rams to incentivize the live and humane capture of
17		fera	l chickens, such as a feral chicken redemption
18		cent	er or live capture rewards for adult chickens;
19	(4)	Mech	anisms to minimize diseased feral chickens; and

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1 (5) Any other matters deemed appropriate by the department 2 of land and natural resources and department of 3 agriculture. 4 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general 5 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so 6 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 and 7 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal 8 year 2024-2025 to establish one full-time equivalent (1.0 FTE) 9 natural resources management specialist position related to 10 feral chicken management. 11 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department 12 of land and natural resources for the purposes of this Act. 13 SECTION 3.
