H.B. NO. 604

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HOTEL WORKERS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that, according to the 2 university of Hawaii, the accommodation and food services sector 3 of the State's economy employed 113,417 people in 2020. 4 Throughout the State, hotels are privately owned by 5 multinational corporations having directors, executives, and 6 shareholders that are not residents of the State. Hotels are 7 bought and sold on the open market regularly and numerous 8 industries throughout the United States operate successfully as 9 cooperatives.

10 The legislature believes that developing a process for 11 employees of a bankrupt hotel to purchase and operate that hotel 12 as a cooperative business could prevent increased unemployment 13 in the State. The Priory Hotel in Scotland, the hotels of 14 Quaintance-Weaver Restaurants and Hotels in North Carolina, and 15 the hotels of TPI Hospitality in Minnesota are some of the many 16 successful employee-owed hotels.



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Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to provide grants
 to match funds for hotel employees to buy hotels and establish
 employee-owned hotel cooperatives.

4 SECTION 2. (a) The department of business, economic 5 development, and tourism shall establish a program to provide 6 grants for hotel employees or entities entirely owned by hotel 7 employees to purchase hotels and convert the properties into 8 employee-owned hotel cooperatives; provided that no funds shall 9 be made available to any hotel employee or entity entirely owned 10 by hotel employees unless that hotel employee or entity entirely owned by hotel employees provides matching funds on a 11 12 dollar-for-dollar basis.

(b) The department of business, economic development, and
tourism shall adopt rules in accordance with chapter 91, Hawaii
Revised Statutes, as may be necessary to effectuate the program
established under this section.

17 (c) The program established by this section shall18 terminate on June 30, 2033.

19 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
20 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
21 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 and the

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1 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2 2024-2025 for grants to hotel employees to purchase hotels and 3 convert these properties into employee-owned hotel cooperatives; 4 provided that the moneys appropriated pursuant to this section 5 shall not lapse at the end of the fiscal year for which the 6 moneys have been appropriated; provided further that any moneys 7 appropriated pursuant to this section that are unencumbered as 8 of June 30, , shall lapse on that date.

9 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
10 of business, economic development, and tourism for the purposes
11 of this Act.

12 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2023.
