

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE STATE TRAFFIC CODE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 291C, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated		
3	and to read as follows:		
4	" <u>§291C- Human habitation in cars.</u> (a)		
5	Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, a person may use any		
6	vehicle for the purposes of human habitation if the vehicle is		
7	parked in a public parking lot operated by a state department		
8	between the hours of 6:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m., or during hours a		
9	otherwise designated by the appropriate departmental director se		
10	as not to interfere with the parking lot's open hours for the		
11	general public; provided that:		
12	(1) The vehicle enters and exits the parking lot in		
13	accordance with the hours designated by this section;		
14	(2) Each person within the vehicle has registered with		
15	departmental staff or other personnel authorized by		
16	the appropriate departmental director upon entering		
17	the parking lot; and

1	(3)	No person within the vehicle engages in any cooking,	
2		including on a grill or hibachi, while in the parking	
3		lot during the hours designated by this section.	
4	(b)	In any public parking lot operated by a state	
5	departmen	t in which human habitation in a vehicle is allowed	
6	pursuant	to subsection (a), the department operating the parking	
7	lot shall	<u>:</u>	
8	(1)	Ensure at least one gate to the parking lot remains	
9		unlocked at all times; and	
10	(2)	Ensure the public parking lot is monitored by	
11		department staff or other personnel authorized by the	
12		appropriate departmental director,	
13	during t	he hours established by subsection (a).	
14	(C)	Nothing in this section shall be construed to exempt	
15	any perso	n from any applicable state, county, or federal laws,	
16	rules, or	regulations relating to general prohibitions	
17	applicabl	e to all public parking lots operated by a state	
18	department."		
19	SECT	ION 2. Section 291C-112, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is	
20	amended b	y amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

1 [No] Except as provided in section 291C- , no "(a) 2 person shall use any vehicle for purposes of human habitation, whether or not the vehicle is designed or equipped for that 3 purpose, while the vehicle is parked on any roadway, street, or 4 highway or other public property between the hours of 6:00 p.m. 5 and 6:00 a.m. or while the vehicle is parked on private property 6 7 without authorization of the owner or occupant authorizing both the parking of the vehicle there and its use for purposes of 8 9 human habitation." 10 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
