

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ENERGY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. The legislature finds that in December 2022,	
2	the Lawrence Livermore National Laboratory announced that it had		
3	achieved fusion ignition, producing more energy from fusion than		
4	the laser energy used to initiate the ignition. The legislature		
5	recognizes that once fully realized as a source of power, fusion		
6	could allow the State to more efficiently meet the State's		
7	net-zero	emission goals. The legislature notes that, unlike	
8	fission reactors, fusion reactors produce shorter-lived		
9	radioactive byproducts and are a safer and cleaner alternative		
10	to nuclear-powered fission reactors.		
11	Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to establish a		
12	future fusion task force to:		
13	(1)	Determine the feasibility of amending the Hawaii State	
14		Constitution to include provisions to allow for	
15		fusion-powered reactors;	
16	(2)	Evaluate potential sites that may be reserved for	
17		fusion reactors; and

1	(3)	Identify ways for the State to accelerate the progress
2		of fusion development.
3	SECT	ION 2. (a) There is established within the Hawaii
4	state ener	rgy office the future fusion task force.
5	(b)	The task force shall:
6	(1)	Determine the feasibility of amending the Hawaii State
7		Constitution to include provisions to allow for
8		fusion-powered reactors;
9	(2)	Evaluate potential sites that may be reserved for
10		fusion reactors; and
11	(3)	Identify ways for the State to accelerate the progress
12		of fusion development.
13	(C)	The chief energy officer, or the chief energy
14	officer's	designee, shall:
15	(1)	Serve as the chair of the task force; and
16	(2)	Invite to serve as members of the task force
17		academics, scientists, and futurists having relevant
18		expertise.
19	(d)	The task force shall submit a report of its findings
20	and recom	mendations, including any proposed legislation, to the

2	the regular session of 2025.
3	(e) The task force shall cease to exist on June 30, 2025.
