A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HEMP SPECIAL FUND.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to amend section
 141-14, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to allow the industrial hemp
 special fund to be utilized for the department of agriculture's
 responsibilities regarding hemp created by Act 14, Session Laws
 of Hawaii 2020, as amended by Act 137, Session Laws of Hawaii
 2022.

7 Act 14, Session Laws of Hawaii 2020, as amended by Act 137, 8 Session Laws of Hawaii 2022, established a registry for hemp 9 processors within the department of health, created a hemp 10 processor special fund within the department of health, and 11 authorized the department of health to collect fees and fines 12 for the program. Act 14, Session Laws of Hawaii 2020, as 13 amended by Act 137, Session Laws of Hawaii 2022, also tasked the 14 department of agriculture with monitoring the transportation of hemp within the state and enforcing certain state restrictions 15 regarding the growth of hemp within the State, but did not 16 17 establish a special fund within the department of agriculture to perform these duties. Amending the industrial hemp special fund 18

will allow the department of agriculture to use the existing
 special fund to perform the new regulatory duties relating to
 hemp.

4 SECTION 2. Section 141-14, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
5 amended to read as follows:

6 "[+]§141-14[+ Industrial hemp] Hemp special fund;
7 established. (a) There is created in the state treasury a
8 special fund to be designated as the [industrial] hemp special
9 fund to be administered by the department of agriculture.
10 Moneys deposited in this special fund shall be used to fulfill
11 the purposes of [this] part III and shall include:

- 12 (1) Any moneys appropriated by the legislature to the13 special fund;
- 14 (2) [Any fees collected by the department of agriculture
- 15 in relation to the industrial hemp pilot program; and]
- 16 Moneys generated by the department of agriculture from
- 17 the operations or enforcement of part III, including
- 18 fines, awards, judgments, and settlements;
- 19 (3) The interest or return on investments earned from
 20 moneys in the special fund [-]; and
- 21 (4) Grants and gifts made to the special fund.

22 (b) The department of agriculture may use the moneys in 23 the special fund to carry out the purposes of $[\frac{\text{this}}{\text{part}}]$ part $[\tau]$

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1 <u>III,</u> including hiring employees, specialists, and consultants
2 necessary to complete projects related to the purposes of [this]
3 part[-] <u>III.</u>"

SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the hemp special
fund the sum of \$50,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary
for fiscal year 2023-2024 to be used for the purposes of
carrying out the department of agriculture's responsibilities
under part III of chapter 141, Hawaii Revised Statutes.

9 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of10 agriculture for the purposes of this Act.

11 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 12 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

13 SECTION 5. This Act, upon its approval, shall take effect14 on July 1, 2023.

A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO HEMP SPECIAL FUND.

PURPOSE: To amend the Industrial Hemp Special Fund to be renamed the Hemp Special Fund and used for the Department of Agriculture's responsibilities regarding hemp under part III of chapter 141, Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS).

Amend section 141-14, HRS.

JUSTIFICATION: Act 14, Session Laws of Hawaii 2020, as amended by Act 137, Session Laws of Hawaii 2022, repealed the Department of Agriculture's industrial hemp pilot program and replaced it with distinct duties for both the Department of Health and the Department of Agriculture to regulate hemp in the State.

> A registry for hemp processors was created within the Department of Health, and the Hawaii hemp processing special fund was established to fund the administration of the registry.

The Department of Agriculture was tasked with monitoring the transportation of hemp within the State and enforcing restrictions regarding the growth of hemp within the State. However, there is currently no special fund the Department of Agriculture can use for those purposes. Amending the name and purposes of the Industrial Hemp Special Fund will allow the Department of Agriculture to use the existing special fund to perform its new regulatory duties relating to hemp.

Impact on the public: None.

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Impact on the department and other agencies: Allows the department to utilize hemp pilot program funds for hemp regulation; and allows fines, awards, judgments, and settlements collected by hemp enforcement to fund the department's hemp regulatory duties.
