

HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO REQUIRE DEPARTMENT SCHOOLS STATEWIDE TO INCLUDE LESSONS REGARDING HAWAIIAN INDEPENDENCE DAY, LĀ KŪ'OKO'A.

1	WHEREAS, November 28 was formally recognized in 2023 as a
2	day of remembrance for Hawaiian Independence Day, Lā Kūʻokoʻa,
3	within the State of Hawaii; and

5	WHEREAS, Hawaiian Independence Day commemorates England and
6	France's official signing of the Anglo-Franco Proclamation in
7	1843 which diplomatically acknowledged the Hawaiian Kingdom's
8	independence and sovereignty; and
9	WURDERC Haussian Trademondance Day is known as a day of
10	WHEREAS, Hawaiian Independence Day is known as a day of
11 12	celebration of identity and the joyful pride that comes with being a part of Hawaii; and

13	WHEREAS, Hawaiian Independence Day recognizes aloha 'āina
15	that continues to grow in the people of Hawaii's na'au due to the
15	passion and love they have for their homeland and lands to which
17	they feel an ancestral or spiritual connection; and

20	in the history of Hawaii and knowledge of this historic day
21	should be perpetuated for future generations through the
