HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

ENCOURAGING THE UNITED STATES NAVY TO ERADICATE OCTOCORAL AND OTHER INVASIVE SPECIES FROM THE WATERS OF PEARL HARBOR AND TO PROVIDE THE DEPARTMENT OF LAND AND NATURAL RESOURCES WITH REGULAR UPDATES ON THE STATUS OF ERADICATION AND THE EXTENT OF THE SPREAD OF INVASIVE OCTOCORAL.

1 WHEREAS, two invasive species of octocoral, or Unomia stolonifera and Capnella spicata, are two of many invasive 2 species that threaten Pearl Harbor's maritime ecosystem; and 3 4 WHEREAS, octocoral takes over marine habitats extremely 5 quickly because it is a "soft coral" that does not form a 6 7 calcium exoskeleton like reef-building corals, allowing it to rapidly grow and spread colonies, smothering Hawaiian coral reef 8 9 ecosystems; and 10 11 WHEREAS, in areas where octocorals dominate the marine 12 habitat, there is a lower density and diversity of fish; and 13 WHEREAS, the United States Navy reported the presence of 14 15 octocoral near Pearl Harbor in late 2020 during surveys that were not focused on octocorals, and recent surveys have 16 17 documented octocoral in a much larger area, indicating that they 18 were most likely present before 2019; and 19 20 WHEREAS, a strong unified response is required to remove and eradicate octocorals and other invasive species from the 21 waters of Pearl Harbor; and 22 23 WHEREAS, the United States Navy has conducted pilot 24 eradication projects in certain areas of Pearl Harbor to test 25 the efficacy of various eradication efforts; and 26 27

1 WHEREAS, the Department of Land and Natural Resources has not been informed of the outcomes of these projects, including 2 3 any data collected; and 4 5 WHEREAS, this information is essential to informing the State's response if the invasive species are found outside of 6 7 Pearl Harbor; and 8 WHEREAS, the United States Navy is the principal caretaker 9 of Pearl Harbor and its waters; now, therefore, 10 11 12 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 13 Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular 14 Session of 2024, the Senate concurring, that the United States 15 Navy is encouraged to eradicate octocoral and other invasive 16 species from the waters of Pearl Harbor and to provide the Department of Land and Natural Resources with regular updates on 17 18 the status of eradication and the extent of the spread of 19 invasive octocoral; and 20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the United States Navy is 21 22 encouraged to allocate resources to eradicate octocoral and other invasive species from the waters of Pearl Harbor, 23 24 including West Loch, Middle Loch, and East Loch; and 25 26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the United States 27 28 Secretary of the Navy and Chairperson of the Board of Land and 29 Natural Resources.
