## HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES, DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH, AND JUDICIARY TO PRIORITIZE ENSURING THAT CONTRACTS FOR GOVERNMENT SERVICES ARE ADEQUATELY RESOURCED TO COVER THE COSTS OF PROVIDING THOSE SERVICES.

WHEREAS, through contracts with community-based 1 2 organizations, government agencies provide critical services to the State's vulnerable communities, such as support for victims 3 of domestic violence, housing for foster care and at-risk youth, 4 5 food for low-income households and the elderly, and services for homeless families and individuals; and 6 7 WHEREAS, many government contract rates are set below the 8 9 costs of providing services, and according to a recent survey of Hawaii community-based nonprofit organizations, ninety-one 10 percent of these organizations engaged in contracts with 11 12 government agencies were resourced below the full operating costs required to provide the contracted services; and 13 14 WHEREAS, Hawaii's community-based organizations have been 15 struggling to fill the gap between funding levels and demand for 16 17 services; and 18 19 WHEREAS, some community-based organizations have publicly stated that they may be forced to eliminate or reduce the 20 21 services they provide; now, therefore, 22 23 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular 24 Session of 2024, the Senate concurring, that the Department of 25 26 Human Services, Department of Health, and Judiciary are urged to 27 prioritize ensuring that contracts for government services are

28 adequately resourced to cover the costs of providing those 29 services; and
