
HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU TO ESTABLISH A NEW POLICE
SUBSTATION IN MILILANI TO INCREASE POLICE PRESENCE IN THE
MILILANI COMMUNITY.

1 WHEREAS, Mililani is one of the largest residential
2 communities of Oahu; and

3

4 WHEREAS, Central Oahu between Mililani Town and Waipio has
5 seen several new residential developments in recent years; and

6

7 WHEREAS, according to the United States Census Bureau data,
8 the population of Mililani grew from 2010 to 2020, reaching
9 nearly 50,000; and

10

11 WHEREAS, the population growth has resulted in a
12 corresponding rise in crime, with many residents reporting
13 concern about the increase in and severity of crime; and

14

15 WHEREAS, the latest crime statistics provided by the
16 Honolulu Police Department indicate that Central Oahu saw a
17 seven per cent increase in aggravated assaults; and

18

19 WHEREAS, a series of high-profile violent crimes in
20 Mililani has prompted residents and business owners to call for
21 a greater police presence in the area; and

22

23 WHEREAS, requests for increased police presence in Mililani
24 have been overlooked and calls for a new police substation in
25 Mililani have not been fulfilled; and

27 WHEREAS, Mililani is part of the Honolulu Police Department
28 District 2, which services Mililani, Mililani Mauka, Waipio
29 Acres, Kunia, Wahiawa, Whitmore, Waialua, Haleiwa, Waimea, and
30 Sunset Beach; and

2 WHEREAS, despite the large patrol area, District 2 has the
3 lowest number of patrol subdivisions to which officers in a
4 vehicle are assigned; and

5
6 WHEREAS, the Honolulu Police Department currently operates
7 a single police station, the Wahiawa District Station, in the
8 entire District 2 area; and

9
10 WHEREAS, the police substations are located in other patrol
11 districts to provide improved police response and other services
12 to the communities; and



14 WHEREAS, the Honolulu Police Department's presence in
15 Mililani must be expanded to reflect population growth and
16 residential development and to appropriately respond to
17 increased reports of crime in the area; now, therefore,

19 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
20 Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular
21 Session of 2024, the Senate concurring, that the City and County
22 of Honolulu is urged to establish a new police substation to be
23 built in Mililani to increase police presence and improve
24 response times; and

26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the City and County of Honolulu and
27 the Honolulu City Council are requested to support additional
28 funding and resources to create the Mililani police substation;
29 and

31 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
32 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Mayor of the City
33 and County of Honolulu, Councilmembers of the Honolulu City
34 Council, Chief of the Honolulu Police Department, and Chair of
35 the Honolulu Police Commission.
