HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE LEGISLATIVE REFERENCE BUREAU TO CONDUCT A STUDY ON BEST PRACTICES FOR NURSE STAFFING IN HEALTH CARE FACILITIES.

WHEREAS, the State is facing a persistent health care 1 staffing shortage, which has been exacerbated by the challenges 2 posed by the coronavirus disease 2019 pandemic; and 3 4 WHEREAS, as a result of this ongoing shortage, the staff-5 to-patient ratio has greatly increased, leading to working 6 conditions becoming increasingly unpredictable and unsafe and 7 increasing the rate of burnout among health care professionals; 8 9 and 10 WHEREAS, research has shown that improved staff-to-patient 11 ratios greatly improve patient safety and outcomes; and 12 13 WHEREAS, identifying best practices in labor standards for 14 health care facilities will help inform lawmakers on how to 15 improve working conditions for health care professionals and 16 increase recruitment and retention; now, therefore, 17 18 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 19 Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular 20 Session of 2024, the Senate concurring, that the Legislative 21 Reference Bureau is requested to conduct a study on best 22 practices for nurse staffing in health care facilities which 23 shall assess and discuss: 24 25 Existing nursing staffing standards and regulations in 26 (1) other states; and 27 28 (2) A literature review of best practices for staffing and 29 workforce development, along with successful efforts 30





in other states to address the nursing workforce 1 shortage; and 2 3 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislative Reference 4 5 Bureau is requested to submit a report of its findings and recommendations to the Legislature no later than twenty days 6 7 prior to the convening of the Regular Session of 2025; and 8 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this 9 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Director of the 10 11 Legislative Reference Bureau.
