
HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE HONOLULU POLICE DEPARTMENT TO DISPATCH TWO BICYCLE
PATROL OFFICERS IN HALEIWA.

1 WHEREAS, violent crime is increasing in Haleiwa, with many
2 residents reporting that the area is unsafe after the sun sets;
3 and
4

5 WHEREAS, on November 1, 2023, a sixty-six year old man was
6 a victim of an unprovoked attack in Haleiwa, causing him to lose
7 vision in one eye; and
8

9 WHEREAS, another man was stabbed at a party in Haleiwa in
10 December of 2023, by a twenty-four year old man who was later
11 arrested; and
12

13 WHEREAS, according to the Honolulu Police Department's
14 crime mapping, since October 1, 2023, there were three assaults,
15 one sex crime, one weapons crime, and two thefts in the same
16 location where the sixty-six year old man was attacked; and

18 WHEREAS, an increase in law enforcement presence in Haleiwa
19 would help to deter crime and increase safety in the area for
20 residents and visitors; now, therefore,
21

22 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
23 Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular
24 Session of 2024, the Senate concurring, that the Honolulu Police
25 Department is urged to dispatch two bicycle patrol officers in
26 Haleiwa; and

28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
29 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Mayor of the City
30 and County of Honolulu and Chief of Police of the Honolulu
31 Police Department.
