
HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU TO CONVENE A TASK
FORCE TO STUDY PERMITTED EVENTS IN URBAN HONOLULU.

1 WHEREAS, the City and County of Honolulu grants permits for
2 over one hundred events every year; and

3
4 WHEREAS, these events range from parades, such as the
5 annual Prince Kuhio parade, to races, such as the Honolulu
6 Marathon; and

7
8 WHEREAS, many of these events occur in the urban core of
9 Honolulu; and

10
11 WHEREAS, to ensure the safety of participants and
12 spectators, these events often require significant road closures
13 of major arteries in urban Honolulu; and

14
15 WHEREAS, depending on the event, these road closures can
16 last up to twelve hours; and

17
18 WHEREAS, these road closures can be disruptive to residents
19 who live in the area where the event is taking place, sometimes
20 preventing a resident from either leaving or returning to their
21 neighborhood until the event is over, and can impede timely
22 access to emergency services; and

23
24 WHEREAS, there are sometimes multiple events scheduled for
25 the same week or weekend which leads to increased traffic
26 congestion and inconvenience; now, therefore,

28 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
29 Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular
30 Session of 2024, the Senate concurring, that the City and County



1 of Honolulu is requested to convene a task force to examine
2 permitted events in urban Honolulu; and

3
4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the task force is requested to
5 study:

7 (1) The frequency and timing of permitted events;
8
9 (2) The impact of permitted events on the community in
10 which the event is being held;
11
12 (3) Solutions to allow access to residents and emergency
13 services when the permitted event results in road
14 closures that enclose neighborhoods and prohibit any
15 through traffic;
16
17 (4) The permitting process for events and the steps
18 applicants must undergo for a permit, including how
19 the applicant ensures the community in which the event
20 is located will not be adversely impacted; and

22 (5) Road closure management, including any steps the
23 applicant must take to ensure road closures do not
24 impede emergency services; and

26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the task force is requested to
27 consist of the following individuals:

29 (1) The Director of Transportation, or their designee;
30
31 (2) The Director of the Department of Planning and
32 Permitting of the City and County of Honolulu, or
33 their designee;

35 (3) The Director of the Department of Transportation
36 Services of the City and County of Honolulu, or their
37 designee; and

39 (4) The Chief of the Honolulu Police Department, or their
40 designee; and

1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the task force is requested to
2 invite the following individuals to participate in the working
3 group:

- 5 (1) A representative from an entity that has hosted either
6 a parade or a marathon;
- 7
- 8 (2) A representative from an entity that has hosted an
9 event at Ala Moana Regional Park;
- 10
- 11 (3) A resident from Waikiki, to be appointed by the
12 Representative of House District 24;
- 13
- 14 (4) A resident of Ala Moana, to be appointed by the
15 Representative of House District 25; and
- 16
- 17 (5) A resident of urban Honolulu, to be appointed by the
18 Senator of Senate District 12; and

20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the task force is requested to
21 make a report of its findings and recommendations, including any
22 proposed legislation, to the Legislature no later than twenty
23 days prior to the convening of the Regular Session of 2025; and

25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
26 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Director of
27 Transportation; Mayor of the City and County of Honolulu;
28 Director of the Department of Planning and Permitting of the
29 City and County of Honolulu; Director of the Department of
30 Transportation Services of the City and County of Honolulu; and
31 Chief of Police of the Honolulu Police Department.
