
HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A STREAM MAINTENANCE WORKING
GROUP BY THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU.

1 WHEREAS, the flooding of streams has been a persistent
2 problem in Hawaii; and

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4 WHEREAS, trash and other debris can restrict the flow of
5 water through streams and other waterways, thereby preventing
6 the draining of stormwater and contributing to flooding; and

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8 WHEREAS, woody debris, such as fallen trees, logs, and
9 branches, while important to the aquatic habitat, can also
10 obstruct drainage patterns and contribute to flooding; and

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12 WHEREAS, the State and counties are statutorily required to
13 conduct maintenance for streams under their respective
14 jurisdictions, which includes stream cleaning and drainage
15 improvement projects; and

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17 WHEREAS, private landowners are responsible for stream
18 management on their properties; and

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20 WHEREAS, a common concern of homeowners and other
21 landowners is the accumulation of debris in the stream channel
22 that obstructs stream flow, which can lead to flooding; and

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24 WHEREAS, this problem is compounded by the illegal dumping
25 of trash that clogs and pollutes Hawaii's streams; and

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27 WHEREAS, the Department of Land and Natural Resources,
28 through its stream maintenance schedule, as well as other
29 departments and agencies that have jurisdiction over stream
30 maintenance, such as the Department of Education, are often



1 unable to clear all streams ahead of events that could lead to
2 flooding; and

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4 WHEREAS, proper stream management and maintenance are
5 essential to clear waterways and prevent flooding; and

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7 WHEREAS, effective stream management and maintenance are
8 complex, multi-jurisdictional issues that require a high degree
9 of collaboration and coordination, particularly in order to
10 reduce inefficiencies and ensure that upkeep is sustained over
11 the long term; now, therefore,

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13 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
14 Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular
15 Session of 2024, the Senate concurring, that a Stream
16 Maintenance Working Group is requested to be established by the
17 City and County of Honolulu; and

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19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Stream Maintenance Working
20 Group is requested to consist of the following members:

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22 (1) A representative of the City and County of Honolulu,
23 to be designated by the Mayor of the City and County
24 of Honolulu and to serve as chairperson of the working
25 group;

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27 (2) A representative of the United States Army Corps of
28 Engineers, Pacific Ocean Division, to be invited by
29 the chairperson of the working group;

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31 (3) A representative of the Department of Education, to be
32 designated by the Superintendent of Education;

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34 (4) A representative of the University of Hawaii, to be
35 designated by the President of the University of
36 Hawaii;

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38 (5) A representative of the Department of Land and Natural
39 Resources, to be designated by the Chairperson of the
40 Board of Land and Natural Resources;

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42 (6) A representative of the Hawaii Emergency Management
43 Agency, to be designated by the Administrator of the
44 Hawaii Emergency Management Agency;



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(7) A private landowner, to be invited by the Speaker of the House of Representatives; and

(8) A private landowner, to be invited by the President of the Senate; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the members of the Stream Maintenance Working Group are requested to serve without compensation but may be reimbursed for necessary expenses, including travel expenses, incurred in carrying out their duties; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Stream Maintenance Working Group is requested to determine and develop a comprehensive solution for effective stream management and maintenance, working in collaboration with and seeking input from other state and county agencies, private landowners, and applicable stakeholders; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Stream Maintenance Working Group is requested to submit a report of its findings and recommendations, including any proposed legislation, to the Legislature no later than twenty days before the Regular Session of 2025; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City and County of Honolulu is requested to provide any necessary administrative and staff support to the Stream Maintenance Working Group, including preparation of the report; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Commander and Division Engineer of the United States Army Corps of Engineers, Pacific Ocean Division; Chairperson of the Board of Land and Natural Resources; Superintendent of Education; President of the University of Hawaii; Administrator of the Hawaii Emergency Management Agency; and Mayor of the City and County of Honolulu.
