HOUSE RESOLUTION

URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO REQUIRE ALL PUBLIC SCHOOLS AND CHARTER SCHOOLS THAT SERVE MEALS TO OFFER PLANT-BASED MEAL OPTIONS PRIORITIZING INGREDIENTS FROM LOCALLY SOURCED AND LOCALLY FARMED PRODUCTS.

WHEREAS, the State recognizes the importance of promoting 1 2 healthy dietary choices among its residents; and 3 WHEREAS, a plant-based diet can reduce the chances of 4 developing diabetes, lower cholesterol, and decrease the risk of 5 cardiovascular disease; and 6 7 8 WHEREAS, the Department of Education plays a crucial role in shaping the lifelong eating habits and preferences of Hawaii 9 10 residents by exposing youths to new and healthy foods during the school day; and 11 12 WHEREAS, encouraging the adoption of plant-based meal 13 options in public schools and charter schools will promote the 14 well-being of students and help build a foundation for a healthy 15 16 lifestyle; and 17 WHEREAS, incorporating locally sourced and locally farmed 18 ingredients into school meals will also support the State's 19 agricultural industry, help fund local jobs, and potentially 20 enhance the nutritional quality of meals through the use of 21 fresher ingredients; now, therefore, 22 23 24 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular 25 Session of 2024, that the Department of Education is urged to 26 require all public schools and charter schools that serve meals 27 28 to offer plant-based meal options, prioritizing ingredients from locally sourced and locally farmed products; and 29 30
