## HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO CONDUCT A FEASIBILITY STUDY ON IDENTIFYING AND FACILITATING THE REPAIR AND TRANSFER OF PRIVATE OR DISPUTED ROADS.

1 WHEREAS, there are roads in Hawaii whose ownership is disputed between the State, counties, or private entities or 2 3 individuals; and 4 WHEREAS, the State or county agencies are often unwilling 5 to maintain these roads because the maintenance activities may 6 7 be construed as assuming ownership and jurisdiction over the disputed roads; and 8 9 WHEREAS, the safety of persons traveling over these "roads 10 in limbo" is affected by the lack of maintenance to these roads; 11 12 now, therefore, 13 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 14 Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular 15 Session of 2024, that the Department of Transportation is 16 requested to conduct a feasibility study on identifying and 17 facilitating the repair and transfer of private or disputed 18 roads; and 19 20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the feasibility study shall: 21 22 23 (1) Identify and develop an inventory of all private and disputed government roads; 24 25 Consider establishing a priority list of roads that 26 (2) require more immediate attention than other roads 27 based upon the condition of the roads and the volume 28 of traffic on the roads; 29 30 (3) Consider drafting sample memoranda of agreement to 31 facilitate the State and each county in transferring 32

2		the county once the State repairs the road and brings
3		it up to county standards;

5	(4)	Examine a system for repairing private and disputed
6		roads through memoranda of agreement between the State
7		and each county; and

9	(5)	Explore the possibility of accessing federal funds to
10		alleviate the costs of repairing roads for which
11		ownership is private or disputed; and
