HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE COMMISSION ON WATER RESOURCE MANAGEMENT TO EXAMINE THE ALLOCATION OF WATER IN WEST MAUI AND IN EMERGENCY SITUATIONS THROUGHOUT THE STATE.

1 WHEREAS, as a result of the wildfire that devastated 2 Lahaina on August 8, 2023, approximately two thousand two 3 hundred structures--eighty-six percent of which were 4 residential--were destroyed, resulting in approximately six 5 thousand individuals becoming homeless; and 6 7 WHEREAS, the water formerly supplying those six thousand residents and two thousand two hundred structures had not been 8 9 utilized for the past six months; and 10 WHEREAS, the United States Army Corps of Engineers has 11 12 cleared over two hundred fifty lots in Lahaina and anticipates 13 clearing two hundred lots per month; and 14 15 WHEREAS, with a permanent debris-disposal site having been 16 confirmed, the rebuilding of homes and other structures can 17 begin soon; and 18 19 WHEREAS, the Villages of Leialii development project, administered by the Hawaii Housing Finance and Development 20 Corporation, will provide two hundred housing units in Lahaina; 21 22 and 23 24 WHEREAS, historically in West Maui, private landowners have 25 been diverting streams and digging wells for their own needs, including the servicing of resorts and hotels, essentially 26 privatizing water resources; and 27 28 WHEREAS, the Commission on Water Resource Management has 29 jurisdiction over the protection, conservation, and management 30 31 of the State's water resources; allocation of the State's water

• 12	Lahaina and the rest of West Maui; and

14	(2) An analysis of how decisions regarding water
15	allocation in West Maui, the island of Maui, and the
. 16	rest of the State should be made in the future to
. 17	improve timely responses during emergency situations
18 19	that involve the need for water and to ensure that
20	<pre>private entities do not wield more power than the State; and</pre>

21	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Commission on Water
.23	Resource Management is requested to submit a report of its
24	findings and recommendations, including any proposed
25	legislation, to the Legislature no later than twenty days prior
26	to the convening of the Regular Session of 2025; and

.28	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
