URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO ENSURE THAT SCHOOL LIBRARIES AND SCHOOL LIBRARY MEDIA CENTERS ARE STAFFED WITH LICENSED SCHOOL LIBRARIANS AND LICENSED SCHOOL LIBRARY MEDIA SPECIALISTS.

| 10 | licensed school librarian provide their students with the best  |
| 11 | chance to succeed; and  |

| 13 | WHEREAS, more than sixty education and library research         |
| 14 | studies demonstrate that strong school library programs staffed |
| 15 | by licensed school librarians help students do better           |
| 16 | academically, even when other school variables are considered;  |

| 19 | WHEREAS, a comprehensive and professional collection            |
| 20 | development plan is essential for the effective management and  |
| 21 | curation of library resources, ensuring that the materials      |
| 22 | available are relevant, diverse, and contribute to a well-      |

| 25 | WHEREAS, a central location for the school library creates      |
| 26 | an environment for expanded learning and supports diverse       |
| 27 | student interests, providing a crucial space for intellectual   |
| 28 | exploration; and  |

| 30 | WHEREAS, technology and internet access in school libraries     |
| 31 | are vital components; and                                       |
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1 2 WHEREAS, licensed school librarians collaborate with 3 teachers to enhance learning with print materials, electronic 4 books, and electronic databases; and 5 6 WHEREAS, licensed school librarians provide guidance, 7 expertise, and support in fostering a love for reading and ensure students have the necessary information literacy skills 8 necessary for college, career development, and community 9 10 engagement; now, therefore, 11 12 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 13 Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2024, that the Department of Education is urged to 14 ensure that school libraries and school library media centers 15 16 are staffed with licensed school librarians and licensed school library media specialists; and 17 18 19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Education is urged to design and equip school libraries and school library 20 21 media centers so that each: 22 Ensures every student has equitable access to 23 (1)resources and is able to locate, access, and use 24 25 resources that are organized and cataloged; 26 (2) Has a collection development plan that includes, but 27 28 is not limited to, materials selection and 29 deselection, a challenged materials procedure, and an 30 intellectual and academic freedom statement; and 31 (3) Is housed in a central location that provides an 32 33 environment for expanded learning and supports a 34 variety of student interests; and 35 36 (4) Has technology and internet access; and 37 38 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 39 Resolution be transmitted to the Governor, Chairperson of the 40 Board of Education, Superintendent of Education, and State Librarian. 41 42



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
