HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF LAND AND NATURAL RESOURCES TO IDENTIFY ALL APPROPRIATE SITES AT STATE PARKS AT WHICH A WATER-BOTTLE FILLING STATION COULD BE INSTALLED.

WHEREAS, drinking water is a vital necessity for 1 2 individuals and should be readily accessible for those enjoying Hawaii's state parks, where parkgoers are active and subject to 3 sun exposure; and 4 5 WHEREAS, single-use plastic beverage containers contribute 6 7 to environmental degradation and pollution of state parks and adjacent marine environments; and 8 9 WHEREAS, many Hawaii residents have developed the habit of 10 carrying refillable water bottles with them to protect the 11 environment and to save money by avoiding the purchase of 12 13 beverages; and 14 WHEREAS, a decrease in the use of plastic water bottles 15 also reduces the amount of public expenditures incurred from 16 shipping them to an off-island treatment and processing facility 17 for recycling; and 18 19 20 WHEREAS, a grant was awarded in 2018 by the Marine Debris Program of the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration 21 to the Department of Land and Natural Resources, resulting in 22 23 the purchase and implementation of nineteen water-bottle filling stations in three different styles in state parks across Kauai, 24 Oahu, Maui, and Hawaii island; and 25 26 27 WHEREAS, Hawaii has fifty-one state parks, many of which are large and can benefit from additional water-bottle filling 28 stations; now, therefore, 29 30 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 31 Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular 32

Session of 2024, that the Department of Land and Natural 1 2 Resources is requested to identify all appropriate sites at state parks at which a water-bottle filling station could be 3 installed, including those where infrastructure for water hook-4 ups is already present; and 5

7 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Land and Natural Resources is requested to consider multiple sites for 8 water-bottle filling stations at large state parks; and 9 10

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this 11 Resolution be transmitted to the Chairperson of the Board of 12 Land and Natural Resources. 13 14
