HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU TO CONVENE A TASK FORCE TO STUDY PERMITTED EVENTS IN URBAN HONOLULU.

WHEREAS, the City and County of Honolulu grants permits for 1 2 over one hundred events every year; and 3 4 WHEREAS, these events range from parades, such as the annual Prince Kuhio parade, to races, such as the Honolulu 5 6 Marathon; and 7 WHEREAS, many of these events occur in the urban core of 8 9 Honolulu; and 10 WHEREAS, to ensure the safety of participants and 11 12 spectators, these events often require significant road closures of major arteries in urban Honolulu; and 13 14 15 WHEREAS, depending on the event, these road closures can last up to twelve hours; and 16 17 WHEREAS, these road closures can be disruptive to residents 18 who live in the area where the event is taking place, sometimes 19 20 preventing a resident from either leaving or returning to their 21 neighborhood until the event is over, and can impede timely access to emergency services; and 22 23 WHEREAS, there are sometimes multiple events scheduled for 24 25 the same week or weekend which leads to increased traffic congestion and inconvenience; now, therefore, 26 27 28 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular 29 Session of 2024, that the City and County of Honolulu is 30 requested to convene a task force to examine permitted events in 31 urban Honolulu; and 32 33
