HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII ECONOMIC RESEARCH ORGANIZATION TO CONDUCT A STUDY ON SCOPE ONE, TWO, AND THREE GREENHOUSE GAS EMISSIONS.

1 WHEREAS, the State recognizes the urgent need to address 2 climate change and reduce greenhouse gas emissions to protect the environment and public health; and 3 4 5 WHEREAS, comprehensive greenhouse gas emissions reporting is essential for understanding the sources and trends of carbon 6 7 emissions to inform effective mitigation strategies; and 8 9 WHEREAS, scope 1 greenhouse gas emissions encompass direct emissions from sources owned or controlled by the reporting 10 entity; and 11 12 13 WHEREAS, scope 2 greenhouse gas emissions encompass indirect emissions from the generation of purchased electricity, 14 heat, or steam consumed by a reporting entity; and 15 16 WHEREAS, scope 3 greenhouse gas emissions encompass 17 18 indirect emissions along the value chain, such as emissions produced by travel and consumer activity; and 19 20 21 WHEREAS, effectively measuring scope 1, 2, and 3 greenhouse 22 gas emissions is essential to develop a comprehensive understanding of greenhouse gas emissions; and 23 24 25 WHEREAS, assessing and reporting scope 1, 2, and 3 26 greenhouse gas emissions is also crucial to identify opportunities for emissions reduction across public and private 27 28 sectors and promoting sustainable practices throughout the 29 State; and 30 WHEREAS, establishing transparent methods for scope 1, 2, 31 32 and 3 greenhouse gas emissions reporting is crucial to ensure

1 consistency, accuracy, and comparability of greenhouse gas 2 emissions data across governmental and nongovernmental sectors; 3 and 4 5 WHEREAS, identifying transparent methods for reporting on 6 scope 1, 2, and 3 greenhouse gas emissions will provide policymakers, businesses, and the public with valuable 7 information to support informed decision-making about climate 8 change mitigation efforts and the advancement of the State's 9 10 net-zero goals; now, therefore, 11 12 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 13 Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2024, that the University of Hawaii Economic Research 14 Organization is requested to conduct a study on scope 1, 2, and 15 16 3 greenhouse gas emissions; and 17 18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the University of Hawaii 19 Economic Research Organization, when conducting its study, is requested to include: 20 21 22 Recommendations for employing a comprehensive (1)23 understanding of scope 1, 2, and 3 greenhouse gas emissions to accelerate the State's transition to a clean economy and meet 24 25 the State's climate change mitigation targets; and 26 27 An analysis of trends, sources, and impacts of (2) 28 greenhouse gas emissions; and 29 30 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the University of Hawaii 31 Economic Research Organization is requested to submit a report of its study, including any proposed legislation, to the 32 33 Legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of 34 the Regular Session of 2025; and 35 36 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 37 Resolution be transmitted to the Governor, Lieutenant Governor, 38 Chairperson of the Board of Land and Natural Resources, Director of the Office of Planning and Sustainable Development, Director 39 of the Hawaii State Energy Office, and Executive Director of the 40 University of Hawaii Economic Research Organization. 41 42
