HOUSE RESOLUTION

URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO INSTALL SPEED BUMPS AND SPEED LIMIT SIGNAGE ON THE PORTION OF KAPOLEI PARKWAY BETWEEN KAPOLEI HIGH SCHOOL AND KAPOLEI MIDDLE SCHOOL.

WHEREAS, according to the National Highway Traffic Safety 1 Administration, speeding is involved in nearly one-third of all 2 motor vehicle fatalities in the United States; and 3 4 WHEREAS, in Kapolei, speeding is a constant contributing 5 factor in motor vehicle accidents and traffic fatalities; and 6 7 8 WHEREAS, pedestrian safety should be a priority for the State and the counties; and 9 10 11 WHEREAS, speed bumps and speed limit signage can be effective tools to slow down motor vehicle traffic and prevent 12 13 collisions; and 14 WHEREAS, installing speed bumps and speed limit signage 15 16 along Kapolei Parkway would help to reduce the number of speeding vehicles on the roadway and protect the residents of 17 Kapolei; now, therefore, 18 19 20 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 21 Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2024, that the Department of Transportation is urged 22 to install speed bumps and speed limit signage along the portion 23 24 of Kapolei Parkway between Kapolei High School and Kapolei Middle School; and 25 26
