## HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE AUDITOR TO CONDUCT A SUNRISE REVIEW OF THE POTENTIAL IMPACTS OF LICENSURE AND REGULATION OF CERTAIN HUMAN RESOURCES MANAGEMENT PERSONNEL.

1	WHEREAS, human resources management plays a strategic role
2 3	in managing people and the workplace environment; and
4	WHEREAS, the increased need for human resources management
5	by state departments has created a need for all public employees
6	utilizing this resource to be assured that the services they
7	receive are provided by qualified staff who follow professional
8	standards; and

10	WHEREAS, persons who hold themselves out as human resources
11 12	staff are not presently required to be licensed, certified,
12	registered, or otherwise regulated by the State; and
13	WHEREAS, section 26H-6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, requires
15	new measures, subjecting unregulated professions and vocations
16	to licensing or other regulatory controls, to be referred to the
17	Auditor for analysis; now, therefore,
18	
19	BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
20	Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular
21	Session of 2024, that the Auditor is requested to conduct a
22	sunrise review of the potential impacts of licensure and
23 24	regulation of certain human resources management personnel; and
24 25	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Auditor is requested to
23 26	include in the sunrise review a system of policies and
27	procedures that should be followed after a complaint is
28	submitted, which shall be maintained and consistent throughout
29	all state departments; and
30	
31	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Auditor is further
32	requested to submit findings, including the results of the

1 study, any proposed legislation, and a recommendation as to whether the State should require licensure of all human 2 resources management personnel employed by the State, to the 3 Legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of 4 the Regular Session of 2025; and 5 6 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this 7 Resolution be transmitted to the Auditor. 8 9 10
