HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THAT THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION CONSTRUCT ON THE H-1 FREEWAY A WESTBOUND ZIPPER LANE FOR USE ON WEEKDAYS DURING THE HOURS OF 3:00 P.M. AND 6:00 P.M.

WHEREAS, between 2010 and 2020, the populations of the West 1 2 Oahu neighborhoods of Makakilo, Kapolei, and Ewa increased by more than thirty percent; and 3 4 5 WHEREAS, this population increase, coupled with Oahu's limited highway capacity, has led to significant traffic 6 7 congestion eastbound along the H-1 freeway on weekday mornings and westbound along the H-1 freeway on weekday afternoons; and 8 9 WHEREAS, efforts to address traffic congestion on Oahu 10 11 include construction of the Skyline rail system and the use of an eastbound barrier-separated high occupancy vehicle lanes, or 12 13 zipper lane, on weekdays between 5:30 a.m. and 9:00 a.m.; and 14 15 WHEREAS, however, due to the lack of a westbound zipper lane, West Oahu residents must endure grueling commutes home 16 each afternoon; now, therefore, 17 18 19 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular 20 Session of 2024, that the Department of Transportation is 21 requested to construct on the H-1 freeway a westbound zipper 22 lane for use on weekdays during the hours of 3:00 p.m. and 6:00 23 p.m.; and 24 25 26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the Director of Transportation. 27 28 29 30 OFFERED BY:
