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# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Act 4, First Special Session Laws of Hawaii
2	2021, is amended by amending section 1 to read as follows:
3	"SECTION 1. [ <del>(a)</del> ] The <u>department of health may require</u>
4	<u>the</u> department of education [ <del>shall publish a weekly</del> ] <u>to</u> report
5	on [ <del>schools that have a student, staff member, or affiliated</del>
6	individual who has tested positive for] coronavirus disease 2019
7	[ <del>(COVID-19). The report shall include:</del>
8	(1) The school's name;
9	(2) The date the COVID-19 positive test result was
10	reported to the school; and
11	(3) The date that the positively tested individual was
12	last on the school-campus.
13	(b) The report shall be published weekly commencing after
14	July 1, 2021, on the department of education's website.] case
15	counts and related information in a manner most appropriate to
16	public health and safety, as determined by the department of
17	health."

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SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

3 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.



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#### Report Title:

Department of Health; Department of Education; Report; COVID-19; Schools

#### Description:

Authorizes the Department of Health to require the Department of Education to report coronavirus disease 2019 case counts and other related information in a manner most appropriate to public health and safety, as determined by the Department of Health. Repeals the requirement to publish the report on the Department of Education's website. (SD1)

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
