5	on [ <del>schools that have a student, staff member, or affiliated</del>
6	individual-who-has-tested-positive for] coronavirus disease 2019
7	[ <del>(COVID-19). The report shall include:</del>
8	(1) The school's name;
9	(2) The date the COVID-19 positive test result was
10	reported to the school; and
11	(3) The date that the positively tested individual was
12	last on the school campus.
13	(b) The report shall be published weekly commencing after
14	July 1, 2021, on the department of education's website.]
