RELATING TO PUBLIC PARKING SPACES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 291, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new part to be appropriately designated and
3	to read as follows:
4	"PART . PUBLIC PARKING SPACES
5	§291-A Definitions. As used in this part:
6	"Motor vehicle" means every vehicle which is self-propelled
7	and every vehicle which is propelled by electric power but not
8	operated upon rails.
9	"Public paid parking space" means any space that is
10	designated for use by the general public as a space to park one
11	or more motor vehicles upon payment of required parking fees.
12	"Parking meter" means a device located in the vicinity of a
13	parking space for the purpose of granting parking privileges to
14	persons for a certain number of minutes or hours upon the
15	payment of required parking fees by a method allowed by the
16	device. "Parking meter" includes multi-space parking meter

devices located in the vicinity of the parking spaces regulated
by the device.

§291-B. Parking fees; payment method. Effective 3 January 1, 2025, all parking lots with public paid parking 4 5 spaces in the State shall accept payment of parking fees by credit card and debit card. All parking meters that collect 6 parking fees for any public paid parking space in the State 7 shall be maintained in working order to accept payment by credit 8 card and debit card. Nothing in this section shall be construed 9 10 to prohibit a parking lot with public paid parking spaces or 11 parking meters from accepting payment by cash.

12 §291-C. Ordinances to enforce authorized. Each county 13 shall adopt ordinances to enforce the requirements of section 14 291-B, including the establishment of penalties for failure to 15 comply with the requirements of that section."

16 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

Public Parking Spaces; Parking Meters; Payment Method; Credit Card; Debit Card; County Ordinance

Description:

Effective January 1, 2025, requires all parking lots with public paid parking spaces in the State to accept payment of parking fees by credit card and debit card; and all parking meters that collect parking fees for any public paid parking space in the State to be maintained in working order to accept payment by cash, credit card, and debit card. Requires counties to adopt ordinances to enforce these requirements, including the establishment of penalties for failure to comply. Defines motor vehicle, public parking space, and parking meter.
