The legislature finds that equitable access to high-speed broadband internet is a pressing challenge for the 3 4 The legislature further finds that there is a State. 5 significant amount of federal funds available to support state 6 broadband initiatives and that some of these programs require 7 matching funds from the State or other non-federal partners. 8 The legislature also finds that the composition of the working 9 group established pursuant to Act 231, Session Laws of Hawaii 10 2022, should be amended to facilitate its purpose in determining 11 the appropriate governance structure to implement, operate, and 12 maintain broadband infrastructure development in the State. 13 The purpose of this Act is to:
