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# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO IMPORTANT HOUSING LANDS.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. (a) The Hawaii public housing authority shall  
2           conduct a study identifying certain state-owned lands that are  
3           located within a one half-mile radius of any rail mass transit  
4           station, including lands owned by the office of Hawaiian affairs  
5           and excluding lands under the jurisdiction of the department of  
6           Hawaiian home lands, that are most suitable for constructing at  
7           least one hundred thousand units of housing; provided that the  
8           Hawaii public housing authority may contract the services of  
9           another entity to conduct the study.

10           (b) The Hawaii public housing authority shall submit a  
11           report of its findings and recommendations, including any  
12           proposed legislation, to the legislature no later than twenty  
13           days prior to the convening of the regular session of 2024.

14           SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general  
15           revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$                    or so  
16           much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 and  
17           the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal



1 year 2024-2025 for the Hawaii public housing authority to  
2 conduct, or contract services to conduct, the study required by  
3 section 1 of this Act.

4 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the Hawaii  
5 public housing authority for the purposes of this Act.

6 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on June 30, 3000.
