A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO OHANA ZONES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. There is established one position, to be
 appropriately titled, within the office of the governor, that
 shall be responsible for the deployment of the capital
 improvement funds appropriated by this Act.

SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general 5 6 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 and 7 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal 8 9 year 2024-2025 for the ohana zones pilot program established 10 pursuant to Act 209, Session Laws of Hawaii 2018, as amended by 11 Act 128, Session Laws of Hawaii 2019, as amended by Act 235, 12 Session Laws of Hawaii 2022, including expenses relating to 13 operations, upkeep of facilities, provision of services, and 14 administrative costs.

15 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the office of 16 the governor for the purposes of this Act; provided that the 17 governor shall transfer the expenditure authority to designated

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executive branch departments or agencies within a reasonable
 time.

The appropriations made by this Act for fiscal years 2023-2024 and 2024-2025 for the office of the governor shall not lapse at the end of the fiscal years for which the appropriations are made; provided that all moneys from the appropriations that are unencumbered as of June 30, 2026, shall lapse as of that date.

9 Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, the governor 10 may transfer all or a portion of the appropriation in this 11 section to the governor's designated executive branch agencies 12 for expenditures incurred in implementing the ohana zones pilot 13 program.

14 The governor's designated executive branch agencies may 15 expend any appropriation transferred pursuant to this section 16 for the performance of their respective duties under the ohana 17 zones pilot program.

SECTION 3. The director of finance is authorized to issue general obligation bonds in the sum of \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2023-2024

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1 for the purpose of constructing facilities for the ohana zones 2 pilot program established pursuant to Act 209, Session Laws of 3 Hawaii 2018, as amended by Act 128, Session Laws of Hawaii 2019, 4 as amended by Act 235, Session Laws of Hawaii 2022; provided 5 that:

6 (1) The appropriation made for the capital improvement
7 project authorized by this section shall not lapse at
8 the end of the fiscal biennium for which the
9 appropriation is made; and

10 (2) All moneys from the appropriation unencumbered as of
11 June 30, 2026, shall lapse as of that date.

12 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the office of the 13 governor for the purposes of this Act; provided that the 14 governor shall transfer the expenditure authority to designated 15 executive branch departments or agencies within a reasonable 16 time.

Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, the governor may transfer all or a portion of the appropriation in this section to the governor's designated executive branch agencies for expenditures incurred in implementing the ohana zones pilot program.

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The governor's designated executive branch agencies may
 expend any appropriation transferred pursuant to this section
 for the performance of their respective duties under the ohana
 zones pilot program.

5 SECTION 4. The exemptions enumerated in section 3 of Act
6 235, Session Laws of Hawaii 2022, shall apply to ohana zone
7 construction pursuant to this Act.

8 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.



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Report Title: Ohana Zones Pilot Program; Appropriation

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Description:

Appropriates funds for the ohana zones pilot program, including expenses relating to operations, upkeep of facilities, provision of services, and administrative costs. Authorizes the issuance of general obligation bonds for the construction of facilities for the ohana zones pilot program. Establishes one position within the Office of the Governor that is responsible for the deployment of the capital improvement funds appropriated by this Act. Specifies certain exemptions shall apply to the ohana zone construction. Effective 7/1/2050. (SD2)

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
